# Material list for 20 Kites

You Will Need:

20 sheets of 8.5 x 11in. paper. Bright colors are especially cheerful in the sky.

20 plastic coffee stirrs for use as cross sticks. Plastic straws, bamboo bar-b-que sticks or even a thin stiff strip of plastic may also be used.

1 roll of vinyl tape available at most hardware or building supply stores. Also called Surveyor's flagging. Other tails can be made by taping several flat bows or other designs to a piece of string.

1 roll of masking tape .5 to 1.in wide or any type of stick plastic tape

1 roll of string. Enough for 6 to 10 feet of string for each kite.

20 small 1 x 2 in. cardboard rectangles on which to wind the string. This may be prepared beforehand for very young children.

1 Scissors.

1 Hole punch.

**20 New Paper Kite Designs**

Fold, Cut, Tape & Fly

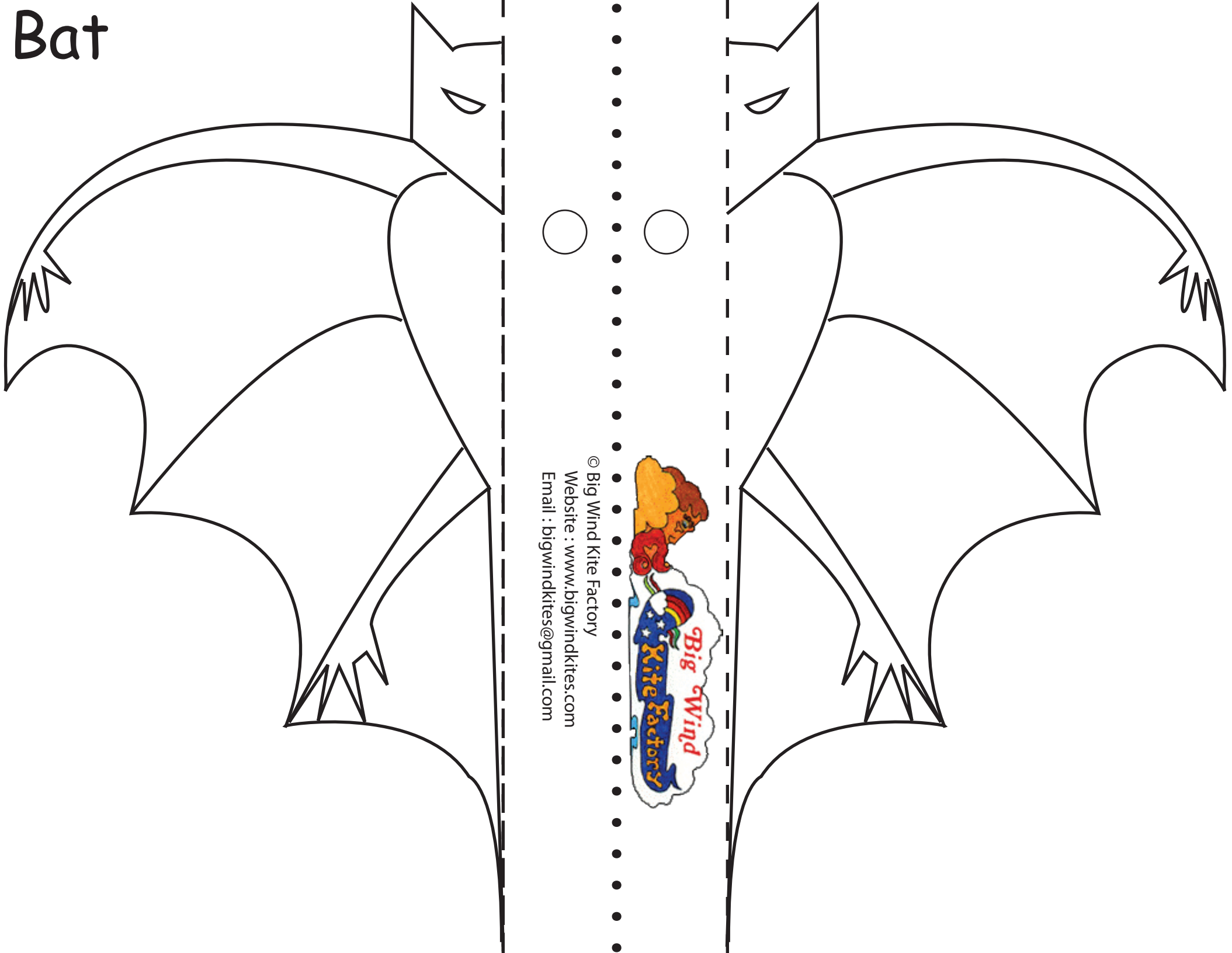
1. Fold paper in half along the **dotted** line.
2. With the paper still folded, cut out the **outline** of design to create a symmetrical kite.
3. Fold paper again along the **dashed** line to create a center keel.
4. Fold back the **top sheet** of paper along the **dashed** line so that the design is facing down.
5. Place a 6 or 7 inch peice of masking tape firmly along the vertical fold starting at the top of the kite. (No stick is needed here bcause the fold creates a spine that stiffins the paper)
6. Now for the cross stick. First cut a piece masking tape the length of your stick. Then find a point 2 to 3 inches below the top of the kite.
7. Tape your plastic “coffee stir-er” or “bar-b-que” stick perpendicular to the spine 2 to 3 inches from the top of the kite. This is **Usually** opposite the string hole & at or near the widest point of the kite. Tape firmly. **Stick position can vary depending on design.**
8. Cut off 6 to 10 feet of plastic trail ribbon, aka survayers tape, for a tail.
9. Tape the ribbon to the bottom center of the kite with a one inch piece of masking tape.
10. Flip kite over onto its back and fold the spine back and forth along **dashed** line until the spine stands straight up. (Otherwise it acts like a rudder and the kite spins around in circles.)
11. Punch a hole through the circles on the spine.
12. Tie one end of the string to the hole. Reinforce the hole with an additional piece of tape and wind the other end of the string onto the cardboard string winder.

Your kite is now ready for it's maiden voyage. Aloha & Enjoy.

Instructions for the Original  
20 Kids, 20 Kite, 20 Minutes

**Fold n` Fly**  
paper kite

1. Fold a sheet of 8 1/2" x 11" paper in half to 8 1/2" x 5 1/2" along the dotted line.
2. Fold paper again along the **dashed** line to create a center keel.
3. Fold back the **top sheet** of paper along the **dashed** line so that the paper creates a kite shape.
4. Place a 6 or 7 inch peice of masking tape firmly along the vertical fold starting at the top of the kite. (No stick is needed here bcause the fold creates a spine that stiffins the paper)
5. Now for the cross stick. First cut a piece masking tape the length of your stick. Then find a point 2 to 3 inches below the top of the kite.
6. Tape your plastic "coffee stir-er" or "bar-b-que" stick perpendicular to the spine 2 to 3 inches from the top of the kite. This is **Usually** opposite the string hole & at or near the widest point of the kite. Tape firmly.
7. Cut off 6 to 10 feet of plastic trail ribbon, aka survayers tape, for a tail.
8. Tape the ribbon to the bottom center of the kite with a one inch piece of masking tape.
9. Flip kite over onto its back and fold the spine back and forth along **dashed** line until the spine stands straight up. (Otherwise it acts like a rudder and the kite spins around in circles.)
10. Punch a hole through the circles on the spine.
11. Tie one end of the string to the hole. Reinforce the hole with an additional piece of tape and wind the other end of the string onto the cardboard string winder.

Your kite is now ready for it's maiden voyage. Aloha & Enjoy.
