GOAL: To prepare teachers, facilitators, nurses, and nursing/medical students to effectively facilitate the BIG DECISIONS Sexuality Curriculum

OBJECTIVES: After participating in this program, the participant will be able to:

1. Describe the philosophy and approach of BIG DECISIONS
2. Explain strategies for providing a safe learning environment
3. Describe 6 important sexually transmitted diseases and their consequences
4. Compare the effectiveness of methods (including abstinence) for preventing pregnancy
5. Discuss 3 key activities in the BIG DECISIONS Curriculum, including the teaching strategy of each
