Summary:

ZELTIQ has an outstanding opportunity for database administrator to maintain, enhance, and performance tune production databases that support enterprise wide applications, while ensuring high levels of data availability. The enterprise application environment is rapidly growing. This position is in a dynamic environment and the successful candidate will need to be a self-starting, quick learning, detail oriented, highly motivated individual that works well in a team setting.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following (other duties may be assigned.):

- Maintain existing SAP Business One system and all associated add-ons, implement new add-ons.
- Maintain change control and testing processes for modifications to databases.
- Perform database transaction and security audits.
- Set up users in enterprise applications and maintain appropriate end-user database access control levels.
- Create, or support creation of, ad hoc queries in response to business user needs.
- Respond to and resolve database access and performance issues.
- Coordinate data migrations between systems.
- Monitor, optimize and allocate physical data storage for database systems.
- Install and configure relevant network components to ensure database access as well as database consistency and integrity.
- Monitor database system details within the database, including stored procedures and execution time, and implement efficiency improvements.
- Develop routines for end users to facilitate best practices database use.
- Gather, analyze and influence user and system requirements.
- Identify and create solutions to improve system performance and availability.
- Assume additional responsibilities as assigned.
