











To make bat wings, use a sharp, non-serrated knife to saw chocolate wafer cookies in half using the dotted lines for reference. Use halves as bat wings or use large and small decorating tips to twist and gently cut each cookie. Then use a knife to cut straight edges. Insert the wings into dipped cake pop before the candy coating dries.


Spooky Moons



Place this sheet under wax paper and use as a guide. Draw the wings using a toothpick heavily dipped in the candy coating, then fill in shape. Place a licorice button candy in the center before the wings dry. Use a clean toothpick to reshape any bumps.

Make candy corn garland in three sizes. Print out on heavyweight paper, cut out the shapes, and poke holes on the corners of the yellow section. Then weave string or thread through depending on the size garland you want to hang.



