- glue

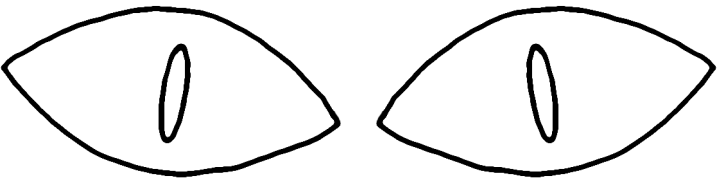
MONSTER FACE**Instructions**

1. Colour your paper plate with paint or crayons.
2. Choose the eyes, ears, mouth and nose you'd like to use. Colour them in and cut them out.
3. Glue eyes, ears, etc. to the paper plate. Decorate your paper plate further if you wish. eg; use feathers or wool for hair.

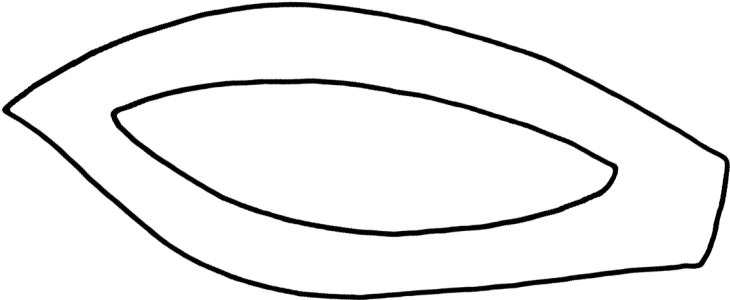
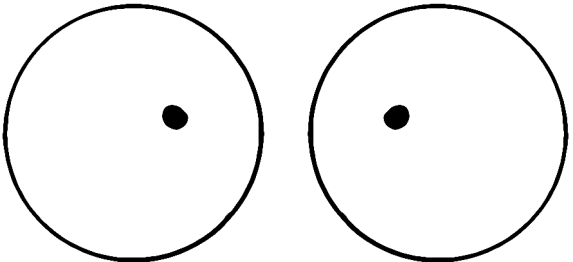
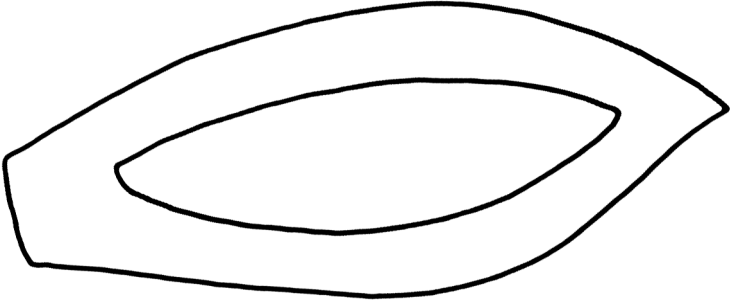
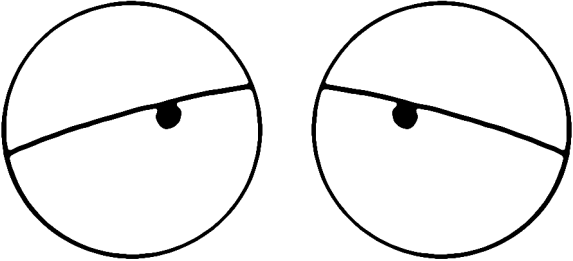
Ideas

Be as creative as you like with the monster plate faces. You may like to give your monster three eyes or two noses. You may even like to make a nose that sticks out by glueing a bottle lid or something similar onto the face.

Cut holes where the eyes should be to make a mask.

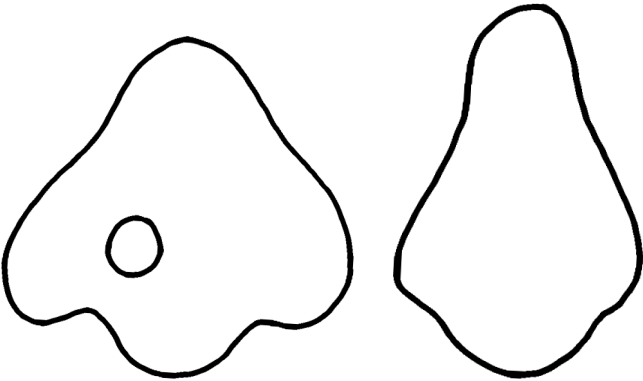


Choose which features you want to use for your monster face plate.

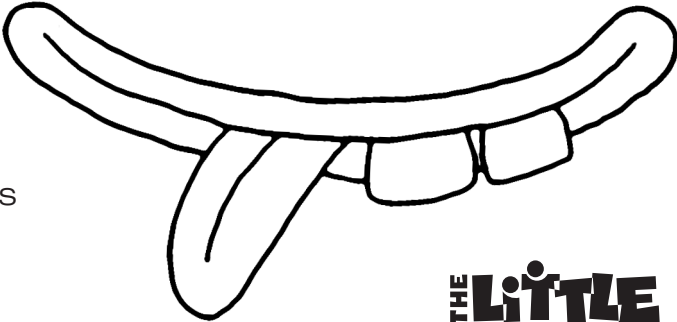
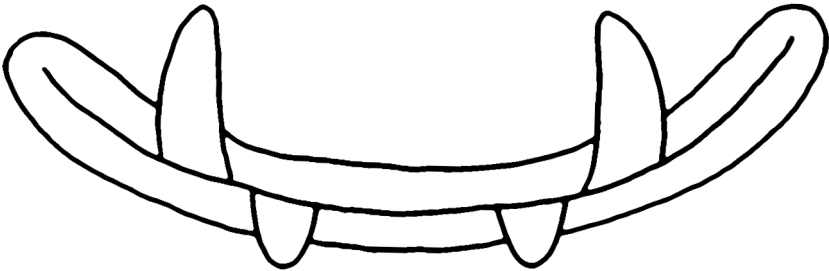
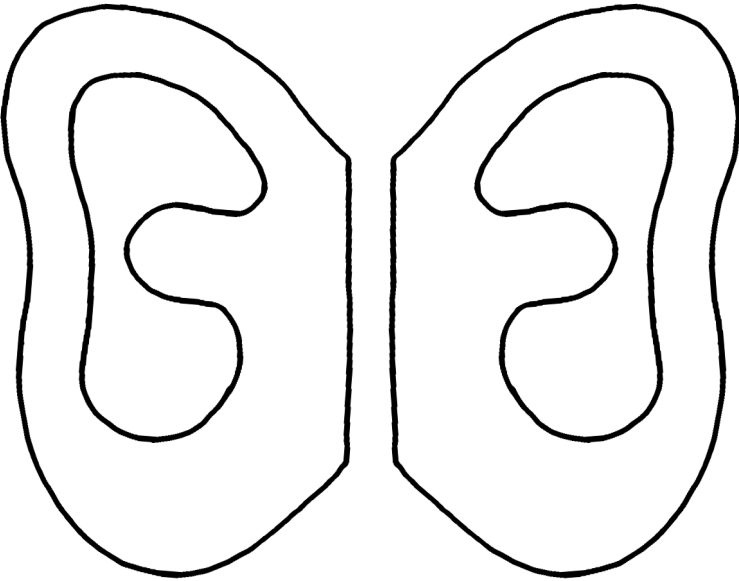
