

Projects - Envelope Liners



A fantastic way to personalise your stationery, and pretty up your envelopes is with custom envelope liners. Making your own couldn't be simpler.

All you need to make these beautiful liners is an envelope or two, some beautiful papers, a pencil, some scissors, a ruler and glue.

Project Materials

Grant "Create a Card" pack in Blossom Glitter

Grant "Bright Young Things" Paper Pack

Grant Studios Craft Super Glue

Step one

Make a template for your liner by tracing the outline of your opened envelope onto light card or paper.

Step two

Using a ruler measure in 1cm (approx 1/3in) from either side and 1.5cm (approx 2/3in) from the bottom of your outline. Trim to size.

Step three

Trace around your template onto the back of your chosen patterned paper. I like to line up the template along a corner to save time. Cut out your envelope liner.

Step four

Insert the liner into the envelope and position. Make sure not to cover the glue on the envelope flap. Fold the flap to crease the liner along the fold.

Step five

Fold the liner flap and put glue around the edges, then press down on the envelope. Your liner is made!

Its lots of fun matching papers and envelopes as you can see. Custom liners give you the chance to make your letters and cards extra special.
