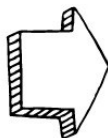

# How to make a Build a Rainbow Busy Bag

## Materials:

felt (red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, white,  
optional: light blue)

zip-top gallon-size bag (type that lays flat,  
NOT with expandable bottom)

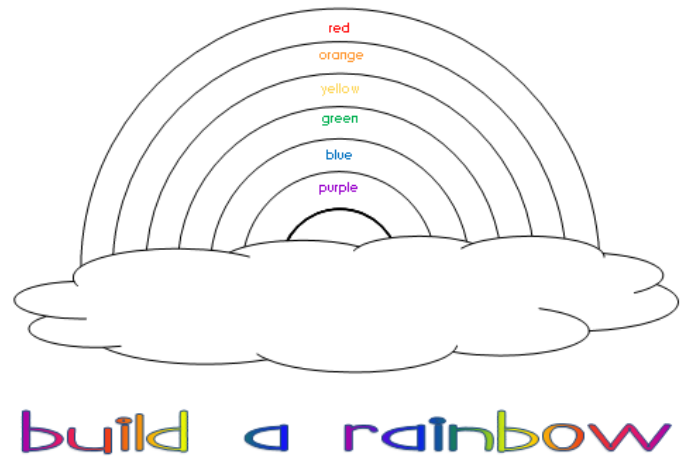
color printer

white cardstock paper

scissors

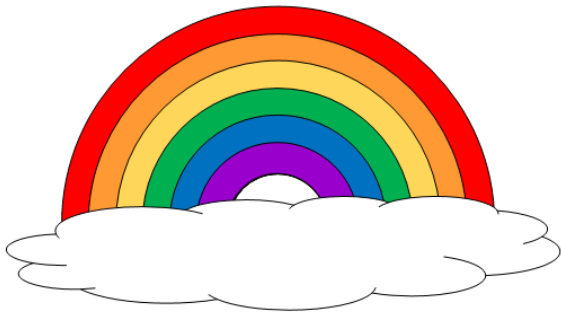
[laminator](#), clear contact paper, or page protectors (optional)

clear packaging tape



## Instructions:

1. Print rainbow template. Cut it apart and use it to trace and cut each rainbow piece out of the color specified. Cut the cloud out of white felt. Place all the pieces in the zip-top bag.
2. Print the color version of the rainbow on white cardstock. Trim the page on the solid lines. Laminate this page and slide it into the zip-top bag. You can use a page protector instead. You'll need to trim off the side with holes and cut the top down to the size of the paper. Fold a length of packaging tape in half over the top to keep the page from coming out.
3. Print the Busy Bag label on regular weight printer paper. Cut it out on the solid lines. Use clear packaging tape to cover and secure the label to the front of the zip-top bag.
4. Optional: include a sheet of light blue felt in the bag as a sky background for the rainbow.



# Build a Rainbow

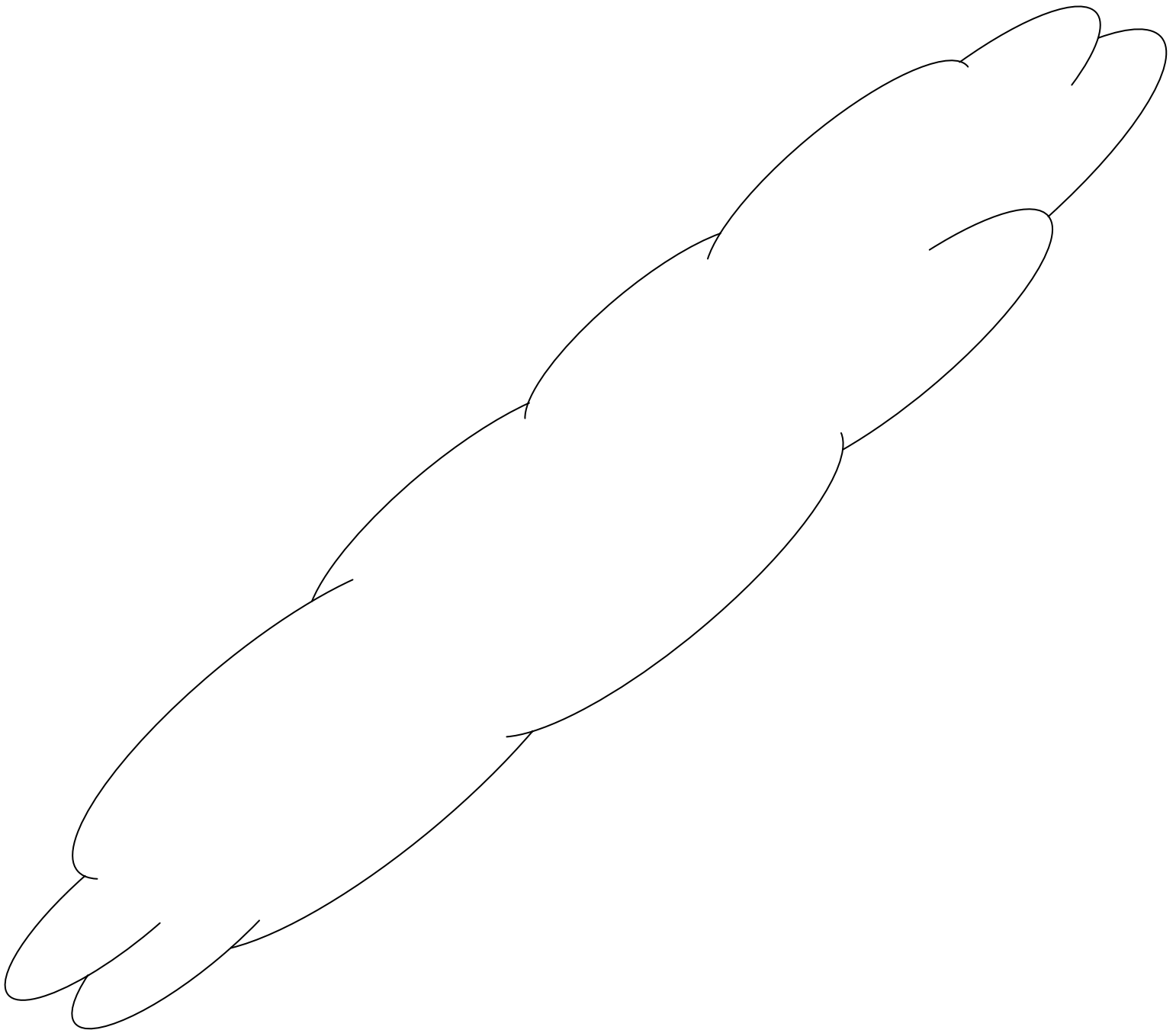
Use the felt pieces to build a rainbow. Start with the red piece and place the other pieces on top from biggest to smallest. Then cover the bottom edge of the rainbow with the white cloud.

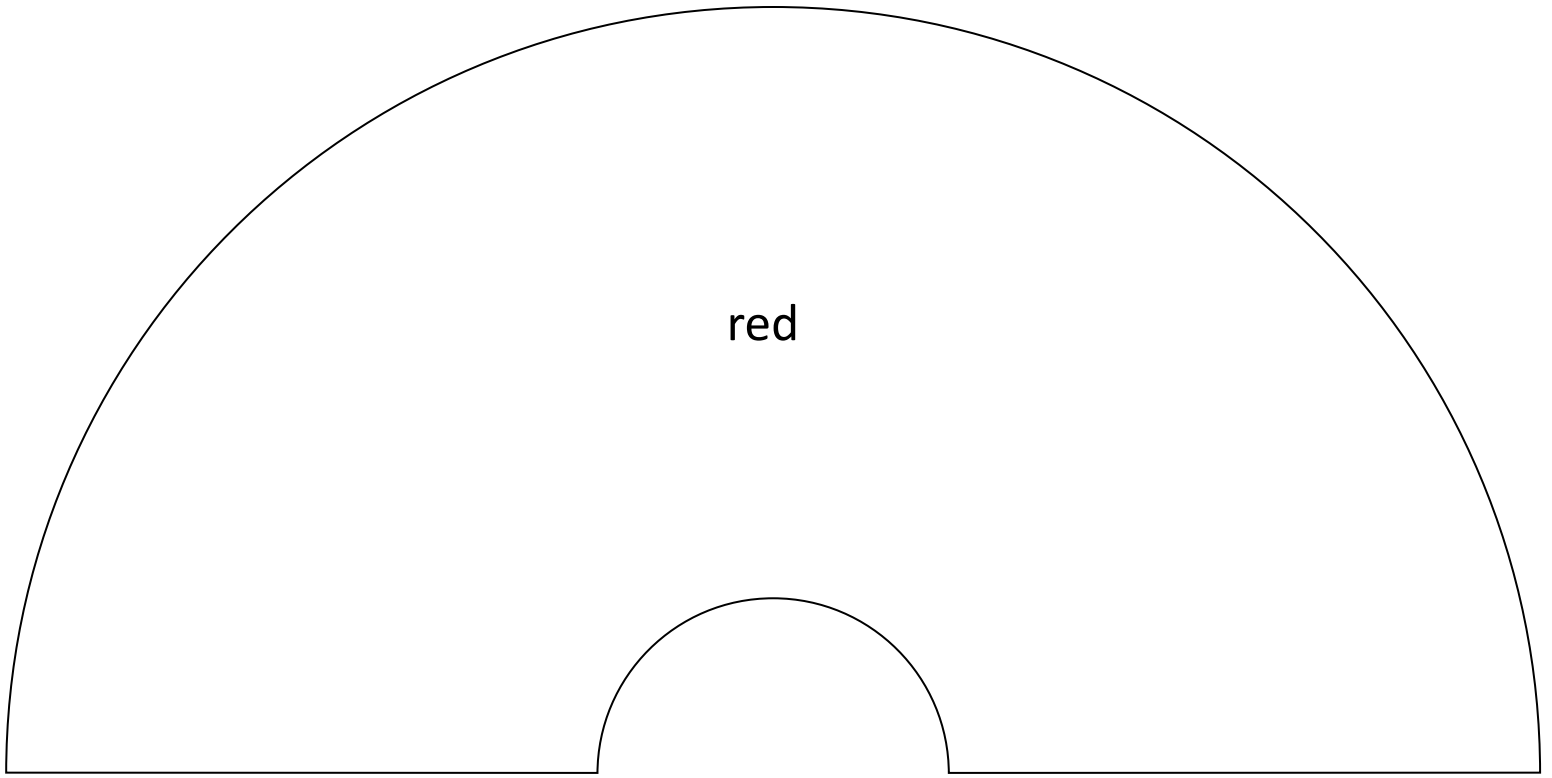
Activity Develops or Reinforces: visual discrimination, colors, fine motor skills, spatial reasoning

This bag includes: 1 Build a Rainbow Guide, 7 felt building pieces

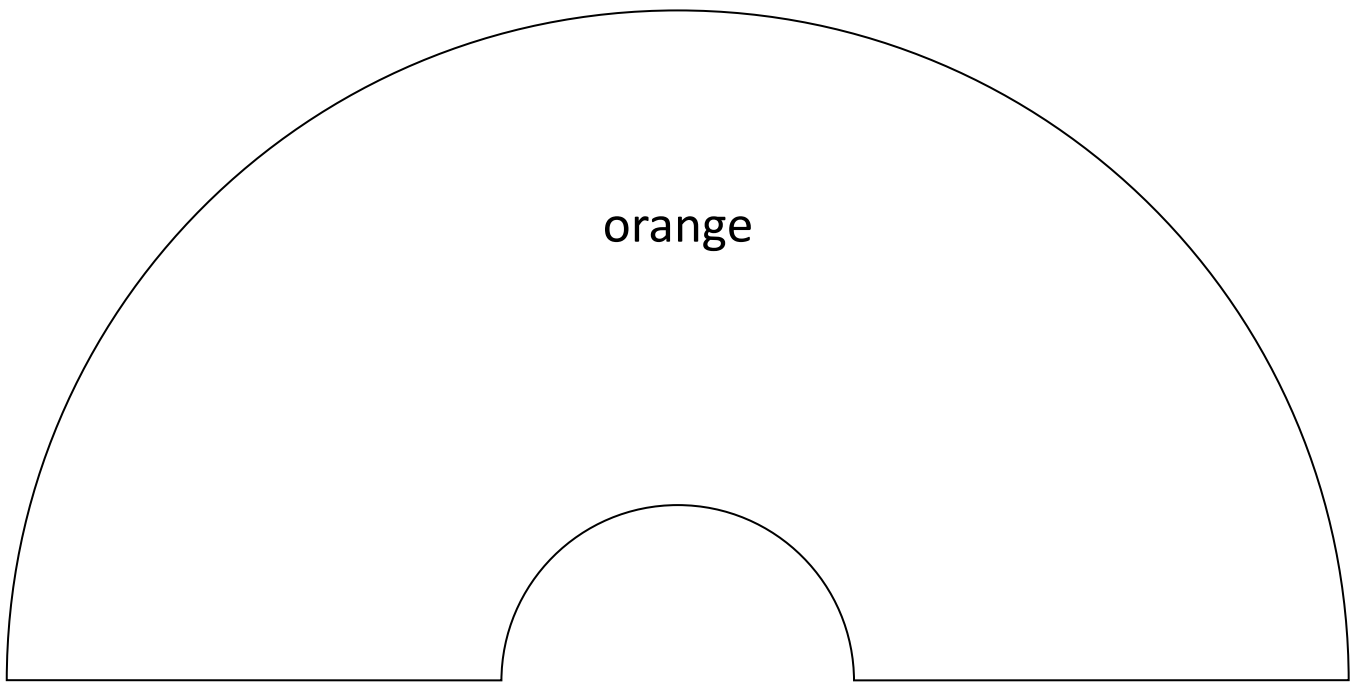
Warning: Plastic bags are a choking hazards. Adult supervision required.
