BACKGROUND: In recent written and oral communications with the Board, we had indicated that the ACRL Information Literacy Competency Standards for Higher Education Task Force planned to submit the new Information Literacy Framework for Higher Education and our related recommendations for consideration at the September meeting of the ACRL Board. However, the response to the full draft of the Information Literacy Framework for Higher Education, made public on June 17, 2014, provided sufficient ideas that the Task Force would like to spend additional time reviewing the comments and revising the document. We believe that the revisions will be substantive enough to require an additional period of review by ACRL members and the community. We do, therefore, plan to extend our deadline as the Board offered during our June 28 conversation. We plan to have the new Framework and our recommendations to the Board by the deadline so that they can be considered at ALA Midwinter 2015. At this point, we tentatively plan to have a new draft available for comment approximately November 1, 2014.
