Explanation

If you are living together and have enrolled your partner with SNPS, your partner will be entitled to a partner's pension in the event of your predecease. If you and your partner separate, you are required to notify SNPS of this. When the cohabitation agreement is terminated, a part of your accrued pension capital as per separation date, is split on behalf of your ex-partner. This part of capital is calculated based on a fictitious bought partner pension at retirement and will only be settled when you are alive at retirement. With this capital a life-long partner's pension needs to be bought at retirement on behalf of your ex-partner. This is called the special partner's pension, which enters into effect following your predecease. The full terms and conditions for the granting of a partner's pension or a special partner's pension are laid down in the pension regulations.
