The American Red Cross helps people prevent, prepare for and respond to emergencies. Last year, 550 local volunteers helped the Cape Fear Chapter provide the following vital programs and services in Brunswick, Columbus, Duplin, New Hanover and Pender counties: 3,161 area residents were trained in lifesaving skills such as CPR and first aid; 601 military families were assisted with emergency communications; 681 military families received vital information through our Get To Know Us program; 19,160 units of blood were collected and distributed to area hospitals to meet the needs of local patients; 396 area residents were assisted with emergency basic needs in the aftermath of disaster; and 35,000+ community members received disaster prevention and preparedness education and information through outreach activities.

The American Red Cross is part of the International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement. An average of 91 cents of every dollar the Red Cross spends is invested in humanitarian services and programs.
