A brief description of our requirements:

Both parents work a 40-hour + week. The mother's current contract is actually 50+hours, so we need someone who can be in our home from 7 in the morning till 5 in the afternoon.

This will mean getting both kids ready to take Farly to school- breakfast, clothes on and teeth cleaned. School is a ten minute drive away or the kids love riding their bikes/scooters and that only a 10/15min bike via the creek bike path/quiet back streets. My husband and I each have bikes that can be used If needed/wanted. Then picking up Farly from school at 3:15. Ren goes to kinder on Friday mornings from 9:15 to 12:15. At the moment I have neighbours helping with Fridays so this day is not imperative to be covered by a nanny or they can start at Kinder pickup time.

On Mondays and Thursdays, during school hours we normally look after Ren's best friend, Abbie. Her mother and neighbour works from home and she will contribute to us having a nanny on these days. Having Ren and Abbie together actually makes the job even easier because they play so well together and you will hardly see them while they are playing!

Key Responsibilities:

- Taking children to school
- Getting children ready for school
- Preparing lunches
- Playing with children and entertaining them throughout the day
- Collecting the children from school
- Being on call should a child be sick at school.
- General household tidying (to make things easy for busy working parents) eg. light washing, folding clothes, dishes, tidying children room.
