Writing Piece

1. **Prewrite**: get all your ideas down on a graphic organizer or make a list
2. **Rough Draft**: write out your ideas in a rough draft
3. **Edit**: self-edit then have someone at home edit for you
4. **Final Draft**: write it neatly on the final copy paper with all the corrections made

Here are some questions to help you get thinking about what to write.

Who or what is your non-turkey?

What is your non-turkeys name?

Is your non-turkey famous? If so, what for?

Where does your non-turkey live?

What are some of your non-turkeys favorite things? (sports, food, t.v. shows, friends, family)

What is your non-turkeys favorite holiday?

Why is your non-turkey DEFINITELY NOT a turkey?
