

Anesthesiology Student Anesthesia Technician Job Description

Job Responsibilities

- Stock call anesthesia carts with necessary items for anesthetic management.
- Check anesthesia machine and set up with appropriate tubing/bag/suction before each case.
- Ensure that ASA monitors are prepared and properly working prior to each case.
- Prepare airway tools (laryngoscope, endotracheal tube, oral airway, nasal trumpet, LMA) prior to each case on call.
- Prepare IV fluid set-ups for use with and without fluid warmer tubing for all call cases.
- Prepare arterial line/ central venous catheter/ pulmonary artery catheter transducer sets for emergencies.
- Be familiar with the location and the use of special emergency equipment (Belmont rapid infuser, difficult airway cart, Glidescope, SonoSite, etc.)
- Ensure above equipment is appropriately stocked/functioning.
- Inventory a set list of essential items and pass on to the daytime anesthesia techs.
- Stock regional anesthesia carts each night.
- Run arterial blood gases.
- Assist in intra-operative care as directed by the call faculty anesthesiologist or senior resident
