Read and answer each question. Show your work!

Addition Word Problems #3

1. There are twelve (12) birds on the fence. Eight (8) more birds land on the fence. How many birds are on the fence?
2. Twenty-two (22) boys went down the slide. Thirteen (13) more boys went down the slide. How many boys went down the slide?
3. Thirteen (13) ducks are swimming in a lake. Twenty (20) more ducks come to join them. How many ducks are swimming in the lake?
4. Thirty (30) dogs are barking. Ten (10) more dogs start to bark. How many dogs are barking?
5. Bobby ate twenty-six (26) pieces of candy. Then, he ate seventeen (17) more. How many pieces of candy did Bobby eat?
6. Sandy had twenty-six (26) pet fish. She bought six (6) more fish. How many pet fish does Sandy have now?

7. The clown blew up forty-seven (47) balloons. Then he blew up thirteen (13) more balloons. How many balloons does the clown have now?

8. Our class got fifty-four (54) books from the library. Then we got twenty-three (23) more books from the library. How many books did our class get from the library?

Answers

1. $12 + 8 = 20$
There are 20 birds on the fence.
2. $22 + 13 = 35$
35 boys went down the slide.
3. $13 + 20 = 33$
33 ducks are swimming in the lake.
4. $30 + 10 = 40$
40 dogs are barking.
5. $26 + 17 = 43$
Bobby ate 43 pieces of candy.
6. $26 + 6 = 32$
Sandy has 32 pet fish now.
7. $47 + 13 = 60$
The clown has 60 balloons now.
8. $54 + 23 = 77$
Our class got 77 books from the library.
