Key responsibilities are:

- Assist the National Logistics Manager as required, including the roll out of NYS activities.
- Work closely with Logistics Coordinators to ensure orders generated from customer schedules are placed on the manufacturing plants weekly to achieve KPI targets in respect to delivery performance, stock coverage, obsolescence and air freight.
- Liaise regularly with the plants, including weekly phone conferences to ensure supply issues are communicated and effective counter measures are put in place.
- Manage level changes through the ECM process with the manufacturing plants and ensure supply to the Customer is to the correct lever by communicating disposal instructions to the distribution centres on old level stocks.
- Ensure MRP planning parameters are in place and maintained, including the setting of appropriate safety stock levels, in line with stock holding targets.
- Liaise closely with the Scheduling Manager on new schedules to ensure all changes are highlighted and followed up with the customer prior to loading into MPS/MRP.
- Monitor stock levels for all products to ensure action plans are implemented to dispose of obsolescence.
- Provide support and mentoring to Logistics Coordinators
- Write and amend procedures and develop KPI's

You will already have a successful background in logistics operations, ideally in high volume, ERP systems driven manufacturing environment where you have demonstrated effective leadership.
