I was housed in a hostel adjacent to the Royal Needy orphanage with good but very basic accommodations. The clinic where I was placed, the Margo Maternity Clinic, was a 10 minute tro tro ride down the road and working there was AWESOME. The people I met there were incredibly nice and helpful and friendly. I spent most of my volunteer time doing patient check-ins: taking blood pressure, weights, and basic histories. I also gave birth control injections, quinine injections and inserted several IVs. Other than the volunteering part of the trip I would say I was mostly left to my own devices which were scary at first but once I got used to it was kind of nice. Note to future volunteers: Ghana does not accept traveler's checks except in the capitol. You will not be in the capitol. Find another way to bring money.
