Initial Report

On 10/1/16 at 0228 hrs. I was dispatched to 940 N. Leavitt Rd., Taco Bell, in reference to a private property hit skip accident. The complainant, Richard Eichenlaub (46) of Amherst, advised his vehicle was backed into by a red Ford with possible Ohio registration GOM4265.

Upon arrival, I met with Eichenlaub and observed red paint scuffs and scratches on the left front bumper of his 2015 Ford Taurus bearing Ohio registration RUDEONE. Eichenlaub advised he was waiting to go through the drive through line directly behind the suspect vehicle but had not yet entered the drive through lane as it was packed with cars. Eichenlaub advised the red Ford in front of him appeared to grow impatient, placed his vehicle in reverse, and backed up, striking Eichenlaub's vehicle in the front bumper with its rear bumper. Eichenlaub got out of his car and yelled at the driver, who placed his car in drive and fled the area southbound on N. Leavitt Rd. I advised Eichenlaub the license plate he provided returned to a Ford station wagon out of Columbus and didn't appear to match what he described. Eichenlaub agreed and believed he observed the plate wrong. Eichenlaub advised the vehicle was operated by a younger male. Due to the location of the vehicles at the time of the crash, there is no available video surveillance. I attempted to search several different combinations of GOM4265 but was unable to come up with a match to the described hit skip vehicle.

Eichenlaub is insured by State Farm Insurance; policy #438 8237-B12-35D. This report will be considered closed unless the other driver comes forward.
