Liberty Mutual Insurance is a diversified worldwide insurance company that began operations in Boston, Massachusetts in 1912 and first started doing business in Texas in 1924. Today we employ more than 50,000 employees in over 900 offices in 30 countries and economies with our Texas operations employing more than 2,200 individuals in approximately 35 offices.

Our new Plano building will be a state-of-the-art campus for more than 4,000 employees located near amenities such as restaurants, shops, apartments, health clubs, daycare and more to help them balance the demands of their personal and professional lives.
