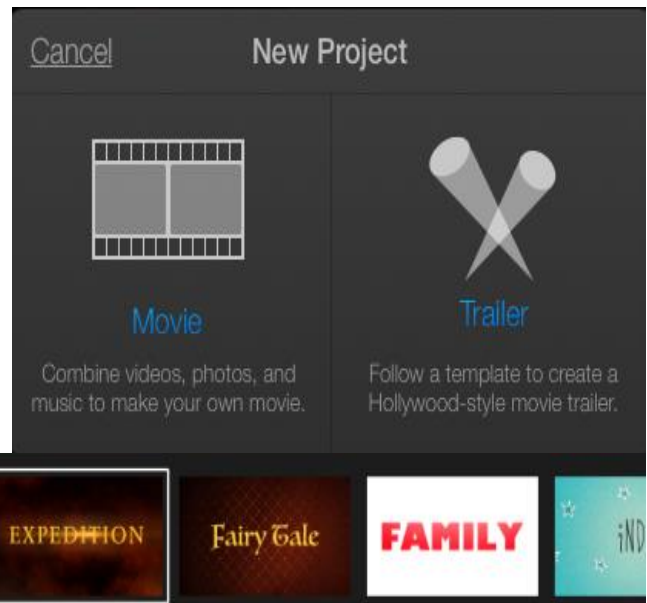


How to with iMovie

- Click the “+” symbol, in the top right corner, to start a new movie or trailer.

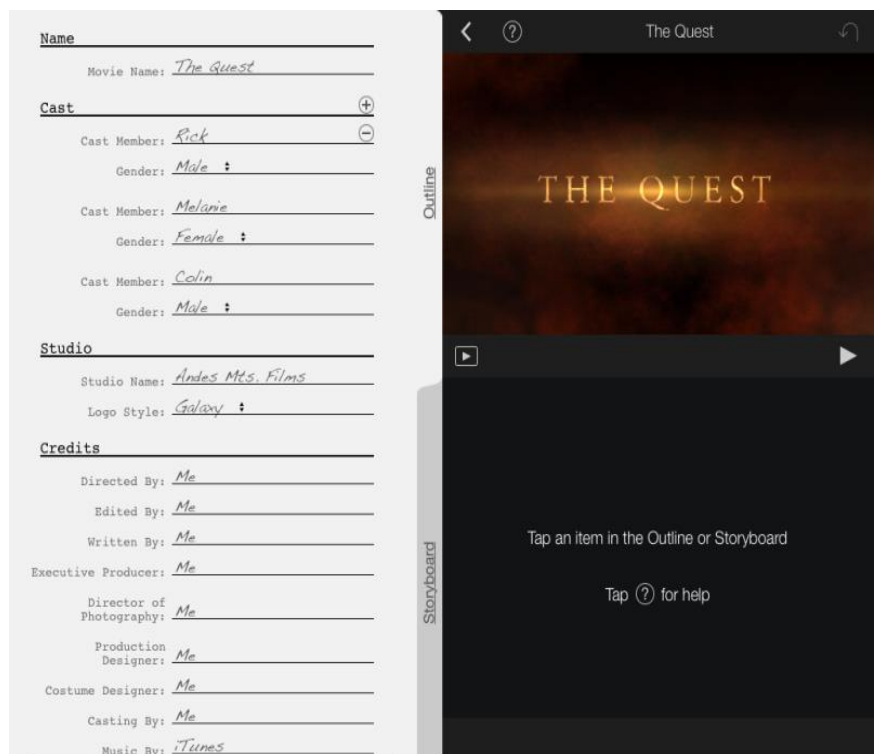
Making a Trailer:

- After clicking the “+” symbol, click on **Trailer**.
- Pick the appropriate “theme” for your trailer. Here are some possible themes:
 - Adrenaline
 - Bollywood
 - Expedition
 - Fairy Tale
 - Family
 - Narrative
 - Retro
 - Romance
 - Scary
 - Superhero
 - Teen



- Some trailers require more pictures and/or videos than other trailers. Some trailers require more characters as well. Therefore, preview several trailers before choosing one.

- Click **Create Trailer** at the top right.
- Complete the **Outline** section first.
 - Name:** Use the book title or create a “catchy,” yet appropriate, new title for the book.
 - Cast:** Include the name and gender for all cast members. You **CANNOT** add more cast members but **SOMETIMES** you can delete cast members.
 - Studio:** The studio name and logo should have some connection to the title or theme of the book.
 - Credits:** Include the names of **ALL** participants.



- Click on **Storyboard** and complete this section next. Here are some helpful hints for this section:

- **Blue Text Lines:** These lines represent text that will be shown during the trailer. You should think of these lines as “**breakers**,” going from one major topic or event to the next.
- **Progression:** Your trailer should, for the most part, progress in **chronological order**. You do not have to show the ending but the setting, characters and conflict should be shown in the trailer.
- **Photos:** There are different types of photos or videos that the trailer requests such as action, wide, landscape, group & individual shots.
 - You **CANNOT** change the type, length or order of the photos. If the trailer asks for group, wide & close-up, you cannot change the order to wide, group & close-up.
- **Adding Photos:** Only photos & videos that are saved to the iPads camera roll can be added to the trailer.
- **Deleting Photos:** Click on the photo in the storyboard. Click the **Trash Bin** symbol to delete the photo from the trailer.
- **Previewing:** Preview the trailer often. Click the **Play** button to preview & the **Pause** button to stop.
- **Sharing:** When the trailer is complete, click the arrow button in the top middle. Click the symbol. Click **Save Video**. Click **Medium – 360p**. Once that’s complete, the trailer has been saved to the iPads camera roll.
