LEVEL TWO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Continued misbehavior in same day ◆ Intentionally throwing objects on the roof, over fence, etc. ◆ Inappropriate language or tone with an adult or peer ◆ Cheating/lying ◆ Rough play—running, pushing, shoving, spitting ◆ Chronic Level 1 behaviors 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Ongoing harassment through notes, email, phone, or other forms of communication ◆ Insults based on size, gender, race, ability, religion, athletic ability, intelligence, ethnicity ◆ Fight words ◆ Intimidation through continued gossiping, teasing, or destructive humor ◆ Chronic Level 1 behaviors 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Defacing property ◆ Playing tricks to embarrass others ◆ Stealing ◆ Chronic Level 1 behaviors 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Threatening physical harm ◆ Starting fight ◆ Purposeful scratching, headlocks, biting, tripping ◆ Other physical altercations ◆ Chronic Level 1 behaviors 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Recess Detention ◆ Phone Call Home ◆ Note/Citation Home ◆ Individual Behavior Plan ◆ Office Referral to Principal ◆ Principal Determines from Level 3 Options ◆ Counseling Referral (When Appropriate)
LEVEL THREE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Behaves in a manner that disrupts the entire group ◆ Fighting (mutual) ◆ Drugs/weapons ◆ Continued insubordination ◆ Running away ◆ Throwing dangerous objects ◆ False reporting (i.e. Fire alarm) ◆ Accessing inappropriate internet sites ◆ 3 office referrals ◆ Chronic Level 2 behaviors 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Prolonged harassment ◆ Encouraging total group exclusion of someone by threatening others if they don't comply ◆ Sexual harassment ◆ Chronic Level 2 behaviors 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Destroying property ◆ Arson ◆ Arranging public humiliation ◆ Writing graffiti with a bias against someone ◆ Chronic Level 2 behaviors 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Making repeated graphic threats ◆ Practicing extortion ◆ Threatening to keep someone silent ◆ Physical cruelty/assault ◆ Repeated acts of violence ◆ Assault with a weapon ◆ Chronic Level 2 behaviors 	ALL LEVEL THREE—IMMEDIATE OFFICE REFERRAL <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Principal Determines Action ◆ Phone Call Home ◆ Parent Meeting ◆ In School Suspension ◆ Out of School Suspension ◆ Reteaching with School Counselor ◆ Law Enforcement Contacted ◆ Expulsion
