**There should be a pictorial representation of each of the following:** 1)PLOT: beginning, middle, end 2)Title, 3) Author, 4)Characters, 5)Setting, 6)Problem/Conflict and Climax/Turning Point, 7)Theme, and 8)your Favorite Scene
