- All proposals must include an educational component or programming. What does your proposal include? Examples are but not limited to: a gallery tour, artist demonstration, lecture program, youth art workshop, community event.

2. Organizer's resume or Bio (not to exceed 2 pages)

- May include bio or resumes of the artists included in your proposal.

3. 20 images of proposed artwork

- Please submit 20 images either in a jpeg format in in a pdf format. Please call if you need further assistance.
- If digital images are not available, you may submit up to 20 images in photographic form no larger than 8" x 10" OR a publication that shows a relevant representation of your proposal. Please do not expect the Lyndon House Arts Center to return your materials by mail or carrier.

4. Exhibition checklist if available

Should your proposal be accepted and scheduled, please be prepared to confirm the following:

Installation requirements:

- All works must be delivered, ready for installation and picked up in a timely fashion as prescribed by scheduling.
- Any specialized installation methods must have prior approval.

Outreach & Programming:

- Provide quality jpegs and content for all Lyndon House Arts Center public relations in a timely fashion.
- Contribute to the Arts Center's programming including educational as discussed above, as well as art reception and other events produced by or during your exhibit.
