

Table Seating

Organising seating arrangements for your guests can be one of the most difficult tasks of the wedding preparations. Once you start to receive your RSVP's you should start to plan where your guests will be seated. Traditionally the Bride, Groom and attendants seat at the bridal table. You may also want your parents on the bridal table; if not, parents and family members usually are seated closest to the bridal table. Tables are usually round, square or oval and consist of 8, 10 or 12 seats. It's a good idea to start organising your guests into general groups.

- ♥ Children's table
- ♥ Friends
- ♥ Work colleagues

Seating arrangements for the bridal table are personal choice. Traditionally the groom and his attendants are seated to the left side and the bride and her attendants to the right side. It is all up to the decision of the bride and groom.

Photo copy the seating plan provided for the amount of tables required, there is no doubt that you will change your mind more than once before the final seating charts are in place, so maybe print some backups.

Remember to state all dietary requirements, children, high chair needed or wheel chair access. This is for the caterers and venues records.
