## Minutes

**Agenda item:** ANP History

The ANP is a gift from the senior parents to the senior class. In the past it has been held at GHS. Four years ago they moved the party to The Castle in Chester. The reason they went to the Castle is because it was easier (no setting up, decorating) and cost less then having it at the high school and as we have since experienced, it left the high school available for graduation in case of inclement weather.

**Discussion:**

The class of 2013 will attend their ANP at the Castle on June 21<sup>st</sup>; we have secured the venue with a deposit. Only members of the senior class are invited. The Castle is charging us \$50.50 per student. This does not include the cost of entertainment, gifts, etc. In past years, the ANP committee gave seniors blankets, gift cards, prizes such as TV's, refrigerators, Ipod, etc. We would like to scale back on the prizes and keep it even for all attending. Fundraising activities in the past have included a raffle ticket sale, sometimes \$100.00 worth of tickets, "flocking" families, and other major efforts to cover the cost of the party. We feel that times are very hard for families and businesses, especially in Goshen with the government building shut down. We would like to keep this years fundraising simple. Therefore, we propose the following:

- We are asking every Senior Parent to pay \$50.00 as a gift to your child for their admission into the Castle. We are requesting these funds by November 21, 2012. All checks should be made payable to **ANP GHS 2013**.

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**Discussion:** West Hills can accommodate 260 people. We received a price of \$21.50 per person for a buffet luncheon, no usage fee, and tax free if we provide certificate, cash bar throughout the event, soda, coffee, tea, dessert. They will charge us \$10.00 per person for models and store owners and supply them with wrap sandwiches. It did not including tips for wait staff. We will also have a dais and podium with mic and tables for raffle baskets; a separate area for the DJ music set up which can link into BOSE surround system; locker rooms for models. We are looking at one more facility to see if we can get a lower price. We would like to charge \$35.00 per person instead of the \$40.00 that has been charged in the past.

The stores we are speaking to are Mr. Kays, My Sister Closet, Style Counsel, Four Winds, NY City Flair, Lia Sophia - Carolyn Freeman. We will need female, male and mother models. We need someone to help with make up.

LaWahna Search has volunteered to help put the baskets together. We will need all donations brought to our next meeting. We also will need help with selling raffles at the show.
