- Auditioning students must stay for the entire two hours.
- When determining rehearsal schedule and “start times,” please consider travel times for participating students.
- Not all students will be involved in every rehearsal session.
- Cast members involved in both rehearsal sessions are asked to bring a sack lunch for the break.
- The snack break between sessions may vary from 15 or 30 minutes depending on the preference of your community.
- The accompanist will begin on Wednesday (second session).
- The youngest cast members, those in Kindergarten through age 7 (school year) or those entering 1st grade through age 7 (summer), will begin on Wednesday and will rehearse the first session for the remainder of the week.
- A four-hour dress rehearsal is required prior to the first performance.
- The show day schedule will usually involve the entire day (including the four-hour dress rehearsal), but will vary according to the performance times.

The Marketing Department is not able to provide a more detailed schedule as the visiting Tour Team takes into account the variables of each community. If you require more specifics, please speak with your Tour Actor/Directors when they call on the Tuesday two weeks prior to the residency.
