## **FOREWORD**

This is the eighth issue of the statistical report "Producer Price Index (PPI) for Agriculture". It covers the period 2002-2004 with 1994 as the base year. As in previous releases, PPI for Agriculture presents the national and regional indices of farm gate prices by commodity and commodity group. The PPI have semi-annual disaggregation.

In consonance with the development in the preparation of other indices, this PPI is planned to be rebased to 2000. The Bureau of Agricultural Statistics (BAS) has included this in the 2006 operational plan. Some changes in the existing national and regional baskets are expected.

Data users and readers are encouraged to give comments and suggestions for further improvement of the PPI report.

## HIGHLIGHTS

## **PHILIPPINES**

- Prices of raw agricultural products increased over the three- year period. The overall PPI soared from 129.7 percent in 2002 to 155.7 percent in 2004.
- Rootcrops still maintained the highest PPI among commodity groups. From 165.0 percent in 2002, this group posted an index of 192.4 percent in 2004. Cereal prices continued to increase with PPI moving up from 152.5 percent in 2002 to 173.9 percent in 2004.
- On a semestral basis and in general, prices were increasing, with the first half of the year continuously recording the bigger PPIs during the reference period.
- By region, Eastern Visayas recorded higher price increases in 2002 as indices were estimated at 153.4 percent in the first half and 148.4 percent in the second half. For the next two (2) years, price increases were biggest in ARMM with PPIs of 157.9 percent and 202.2 percent, respectively. On the other hand, least price increases were noted in MIMAROPA with a PPI of 108.0 percent in 2002. For the same year, only the region recorded a second semester PPI which was below the 1994 base.

## **CAR**

- On the average, agricultural commodities in the region were priced higher in 2002 by 30.2 index points compared with 1994. Further increases were observed in 2003 and 2004 as prices were up by 37.7 and 60.3 index points relative to the base year.
- Rootcrops showed huge price appreciation from 2002 to 2003 but its PPI dropped in 2004. Cereals, vegetables and legumes, commercial crops and poultry exhibited continued increasing prices throughout the reference years.
- Among vegetables and legumes,pechay prices were volatile. Farmgate prices were very high compared to 1994 base year. In 2004, PPI settled at 505.7 percent. Onion (leeks/spring), mandarin and pineapple registered lower prices during the reference years when indices were below the base year.

- Over the reference years, higher prices were registered during the second semesters.

## **ILOCOS**

- Agricultural PPIs indicated decreasing prices for the first two years. From 133.6 percent in 2002, PPI was down to 125.4 percent in 2003. In 2004, there was an overall price improvement as index settled at 137.1 percent.
- In 2004, rootcrops were priced higher than the rest of the commodity groups as indicated by its PPI of 195.6 percent. Commercial crops and poultry posted increasing price quotations during the three-year period. Prices of fruits were decreasing; PPI moved down to 99.9 percent in 2004.
- Throughout the reference years, prices were continuously increasing during the second semesters and fluctuating during the first semesters.

## **CAGAYAN VALLEY**

- PPIs for the region increased from 132.5 percent in 2003 to 154.9 percent in 2004.
- Cereals recorded decrease in prices in 2003 but recovered in the following year with PPI of 160.8 percent. PPI for fruits and livestock showed continuing increases in prices while those for commercial crops indicated declining prices.
- Producers of ginger continued to be the big gainers during the three-year reference period. In 2004, ampalaya and gabi also posted higher price increases with PPIs computed at 220.3 percent and 268.3 percent, respectively.
- From 2002 to 2004, aggregate PPIs in the second semesters were higher compared with the first semesters.

## **CENTRAL LUZON**

- On the average, prices of agricultural commodities were going up over the three-year reference period. In 2004, PPI was 143.0 percent.

- Aside from commercial crops, livestock posted bigger increase as indices were up from 118.4 percent in 2002 to 161.4 percent in 2004. However, annual PPIs of fruits were below the base year.
- Agricultural commodities posted higher increases during the first semesters of the years.

## **CALABARZON**

- There was a general downward trend in prices of agricultural commodities during the years under review. From 121.2 percent in 2002, PPI dropped to 119.3 percent in 2003 and 113.9 percent in 2004.
- Poultry prices recorded a minimal upward movement in 2002 and 2003 but rose significantly in 2004. On the other hand, prices of commercial crops were lower in 2004 than in 2002 and 2003 at 75.4 percent.
- Price increases during the first semester of 2002 and 2004 were higher than in the second semester.

## **MIMAROPA**

- Prices of agricultural commodities were up over the three-year period. PPIs for agriculture in the region were computed at 108.0 percent in 2002, 121.3 percent in 2003 and 134.2 percent in 2004.
- Declining farmgate prices of fruits were registered. Overall PPI for this group continuously dropped to below the base year level in 2004. The 2002 prices of commercial crops were lower than the 1994 level. In the next two years, PPIs rose at 107.5 percent in 2003 and at 110.4 percent in 2004. Prices of vegetables and legumes were also going upwards throughout the reference period.
- Prices during the first semesters of 2002 and 2004 were higher than the second semester prices of the same years. In 2003, the second semester recorded higher PPI.

## **BICOL**

- There was a general uptrend of prices for agricultural commodities in the region during the reference years.

- Rootcrops posted the biggest increase in 2002 with PPI of 160.1 percent. For the next two years, farmgate prices of commercial crops came up with the highest indices of 158.6 percent and 217.2 percent, respectively.
- Semestral comparison showed that prices in the second half of the year moved faster and were higher than during the first half.

## **WESTERN VISAYAS**

- Average farmgate prices depicted an uptrend from 2002 to 2004.
- Cereals, fruits, livestock and poultry showed increasing PPIs throughout the period. Prices of rootcrops and commercial crops declined continuously but still reflected the higher PPIs among the commodity groups. In the case of vegetables and legumes, the 2002 and 2003 prices were quoted lower than in the base year.
- In 2004, prices were almost steady throughout the year.

## **CENTRAL VISAYAS**

- On the average, agricultural products were priced higher in 2002, when PPIs were based at 41.0 index points above the 1994 level. Further increments were observed in 2003 and 2004 at 55.0 and 67.0 index points, respectively.
- From 2002 to 2004, rootcrop prices were moving up faster than the overall average prices for agriculture. PPI for rootcrops ranged from 167.6 percent to 222.6 percent. Cassava prices moved up tremendously in 2004 when its PPI was recorded at 320.8 percent. Bigger price appreciation was also observed for cereals, vegetables, fruits, livestock and commercial crops.
- Prices were higher during the first half of the year throughout the reference period.

## **EASTERN VISAYAS**

- The aggregate PPIs for agricultural commodities in the region showed that farm prices in 2002 to 2004 were greater than the 1994 base year. However, the 2002 prices were higher than the 2003 prices.

- In 2002 and 2004, commercial crops had the bigger increases in prices obtaining 94.7 and 15.2 index points above the 2000 base. In 2003, rootcrops were priced higher by 86.7 index points. Poultry registered the least indices in three (3) consecutive years but still reflected increases in price with its indices higher than the base year.
- Higher prices were generally observed in the first half compared to the second half of 2002 and 2003. There was a very slight difference in semestral prices in 2004.

## **ZAMBOANGA PENINSULA**

- Farmgate prices fluctuated as 2003 PPI was found lower than in 2002, but gained strength in 2004 with PPI moving up to 156.0 percent.
- By commodity group, vegetables and legumes stood out with the highest index of 189.8 percent in 2002. In 2003, rootcrops recorded the biggest price increase with PPI of 165.1 percent. In the following year, cereals showed the biggest gain in farmgate price with a PPI of 172.3 percent.
- Prices are generally higher during the second semesters of the years.

## **NORTHERN MINDANAO**

- Compared with the base year level, prices of agricultural commodities grew by about the same rate in 2002 and 2003. In 2004, prices were higher by 65 index points above in 1994.
- In 2002, fruits registered the highest price index of 176.1 percent. In the same period, price quotations for rootcrops and commercial crops were below the base year level. Cereal prices were higher than the base year by 47.8 and 80.3 index points during 2003 and 2004, respectively.
- Ginger claimed the highest PPI computed for the first two years with indices of 207.2 and 213.3 percent. However, in 2004, rubber was on top as PPI settled at 273.7 percent.
- Higher indices were noted in the first six (6) months of 2002 to 2004.



## **DAVAO REGION**

- In 2002 prices received by agricultural producers increased by 21.0 index points above the base year. In 2003 and 2004, price gains were by 30.0 and 61.0 index points, respectively.
- The highest indices were posted for vegetables and legumes in 2002 and 2003. These were computed at 149.3 and 144.8 percent, respectively. In 2004, livestock recorded the highest PPI of 180.8 percent.
- Farmgate prices of potato came up with higher index in 2002, but fluctuated in the next two years. On the other hand, prices of black pepper and ginger were going down throughout the reference years.
- Higher prices of agricultural commodities were observed in the second half of the reference years.

## **SOCCKSARGEN**

- The 2002 prices of agricultural products were 40.4 index points higher than the base year. The following years were likewise marked by increases at 43.6 index points in 2003 and 68.8 index points in 2004.
- During the three-year period, rootcrops posted the highest PPI among the commodity groups. Starting at 183.6 percent in 2002, it rose to 241.0 percent in 2004. Vegetables and legumes and fruits also earned big increments in 2004 with PPIs of 193.6 percent and 182.3 percent, respectively.
- Individually, the agricultural product that reflected the highest PPI over the three-year period was ginger. The biggest increment was recorded in 2002 when index was computed at 484.2 percent.
- Higher prices of agricultural commodities were posted during the first semesters of each year.

## **ARMM**

- Agricultural prices exhibited an uptrend. From 139.5 percent in 2002, PPI went up to 202.2 percent in 2004.

- Downward price trends of vegetables and legumes were noted. From 159.9 percent in 2002, index dropped to 144.4 percent in the following year and settled at 133.8 percent in 2004. Prices of the rest of the commodity groups continued to increase during the three-year period.
- The second half of each reference year had higher PPIs.

## **CARAGA**

- Agricultural products in the region exhibited increasing prices throughout the three years. PPIs on the average were computed at 136.8 percent in 2002, 145.3 percent in 2003 and 176.4 percent in 2004.
- Prices of cereals indicated the biggest gains with indices going up by 142.6 percent in 2002. In 2003 and 2004, commercial crops posted bigger price increases as PPIs were computed at 158.2 percent and 228.0 percent, respectively. Poultry registered the lowest price indices during 2002 to 2003 while vegetables and legumes had the lowest in 2004.
- Higher prices were noted during the first semesters of 2002 and 2003. But in 2004, the year's second half had the edge in prices.
