

# Call for Participants Just-A-Buck Retail Training Program



Just-A-Buck is accepting referrals to its retail training program at both Just-A-Buck stores (located in South Euclid and Parma). This hands-on training program prepares individuals with disabilities for competitive community-based employment opportunities.

**First Phase:** Interested individuals participate in a 60-day trial period in which they receive a training overview that covers all the relevant tasks related to working in a retail store. Individuals must be referred to Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities (OOD) for career counseling in order to participate. If applicable, participants are rated within 30 days to determine their commensurate wage rates.

**Second Phase:** After the two month trial period, participants have the option to choose to receive more in-depth retail training in areas where they need the most improvement or choose to seek out other training opportunities, assisted by their Support Administrator. This retail training program will not exceed a total of seven months (two months for the first phase + up to five months for the second phase).

**Completion of Training:** After completion of the training program, placement in a competitive, community-based job is the expected outcome for each participant.
