UPDATE OF STAKEHOLDER REGISTER- INVITATION TO REGISTER

In terms of legislation, a fundamental aspect of the new local government system is the active engagement of communities and community organisations in the affairs of municipalities of which they are an integral part. Therefore, the Joe Gqabi District Municipality would like to cordially invite all community organisations or bodies with interest to participate in development matters and affairs of the municipality to register in its stakeholder register. The purpose of the registration is to allow for smooth information flow and identification of stakeholders for participation in the various forums of the municipality.
