Have you ever imagined creating a new form of technology?
How about finding out whether plants grow better in different environments?

Ashlawn will conduct its annual Science Fair this year on Thursday, April 12, 2018, from 6:15-8:00 pm. All Ashlawn students are encouraged to participate. Below, please sign the interest form. Once the interest form is returned, a packet will be sent home with suggestions on possible experiments, display guidelines, and future deadlines.

All interest forms should be turned into your homeroom teacher no later than Friday, February 2. Projects must come to school on the morning of April 12, and will be sent home the same evening. Students will have the opportunity to view other students' work during the day on the 12th.

Again this year, on the evening of April 12, 6:15 - 6:45 pm, students will have the opportunity to present their projects to volunteer adults. Students will be able to explain their projects, and adults will ask them questions about their experiments and inventions. This early portion of the evening is for students only as this is the time they are explaining their projects to the adult volunteers.

From 6:45 - 8:00 pm, students must be accompanied by an adult in order to attend the evening exhibition. Students who choose to conduct an experiment/present an invention should design a display board to explain the process and outcome or explain what the invention does. Models, experiment results, and/or prototypes (inventions do not need to "work") may be placed in front of the display board.
