



Disenrollment Policy

Rationale

Forest Charter School believes that it provides educational opportunities to support a variety of learners. However, due to the unique educational structure of FCS, not all students and families are necessarily a good match for this system. In such cases, FCS feels that it may need to exercise its authority to proceed in a manner that supports the school, the ST, and ultimately the student. Therefore, FCS has adopted the following policy.

Policy

To support student success, all new students/ families must participate in weekly communication and/or meetings with their Supervising Teacher (ST) until the ST feels they are ready for longer periods of independent study without these support meetings. Further, a student who has been with the school but is showing signs of needing additional support may also be required to participate in this process.

- Students may be disenrolled from Forest Charter School for either of the following academic reasons:
 - Missing school appointments or classes
 - Low percentage of work completion
