

**REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR-“ VIDEO PRODUCTION CONSULTANCY”.**

**A. Project Title:**

ENHANCING THE RESILIENCE OF COASTAL COMMUNITIES OF SAMOA TO CLIMATE CHANGE (ERCC)

**B. Project Description or Context and Background:**

The project “Enhancing Resilience of Coastal Communities of Samoa to Climate Change” (ERCC) financed by the Adaptation Fund (AF) and supported by UNDP is managed by the Government of Samoa through the Planning and Urban Management Agency (PUMA) of the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment (MNRE).

Overall, the project will reduce the vulnerability of Samoa’s population and natural environment to climate risks, and enhance the capacity of natural systems and coastal communities to recover from impacts (chronic and acute) associated with climate change and extreme weather events.

The Adaptation Fund (AF) project supported by UNDP intends to strengthen the ability of Samoan communities and the public service to make informed decisions and manage likely climate change driven pressures in a pro-active, integrated and strategic manner. This can be achieved through reduction in vulnerability to adverse impact of climate change; and increase in the adaptive capacity to respond to the impacts of climate change.

The project is now at its final phase of implementation and is looking to document the activities and products it has produced during its implementation. The objective of this consultancy is to produce a 3-minute animation video on the adaptation measures proposed and carried out in Samoa with specific focus on the following;

- Community integrated Management Plans (CIMPs) consultative process and key outcomes;
- Small Grant Programme through CSSP direct impact on the communities;
- Building a more resilient Samoa- SamoaCARES campaign

**• Scope of Work:**

The Consultancy firm or company will be responsible for the production of a high quality, full color hand-drawn 3 minute animated video that explains the results, process and impact of the activities implemented by the AF ERCC Project. This will also be a good platform to raise awareness on the Samoa CARES campaign to acknowledge and further build a culture of climate resiliency in Samoa.

**Objective**

The video production consultancy firm/company or Individual Contractor, will be responsible for the following:

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- Review all relevant information and consult with relevant persons involved in the AF-ERCC project to get a better understanding about activities and products developed under the project so far.
- Submit an Implementation Plan for the work to be undertaken, including the whiteboard animation.
- Review the visual identity, creative brief and draft script provided to ensure a clear understanding of: Who is the audience; what are the issues; what are the solutions the audience will understand by watching the animation; what makes the message unique; how will the audience engage and what mood will be used;
- Upon approval of the final script, present UNDP with draft storyboards. Every drawing must be hand-made by professional artists;
- Upon comment on the draft storyboards, present AF Team with the final storyboard. Every drawing must be hand-made by professional artists;
- Upon approval of the final storyboards, produce voiceovers;
- Provide a 3-minute video animation that include voice-overs and music.
- Support the production of communication elements derived from the original work from the video animation to support the social media campaign or other channels.
