



Athens Land Trust Farm Share Membership Agreement

A Farm Share is a relationship between our farmer network and you as our customer or Farm Share "member." Please read this document in full so that you understand the agreement before signing on as a member.

ALT's Farm Share Program

Our Farm Share will feature produce from local farms. Our Spring 2019 session will run for 12 weeks April 24th – July 19th (Skipping the week of 4th of July). One Farm Share is \$300.00 including sales tax.

Add-On Products

We are partnering with local farms and businesses to enrich our Farm Share program with add-on options. Our add-on products are items that you can “add-on” to your weekly farm share for an additional fee. These products are from local farms and business that share the same commitments as Athens Land Trust and we are excited about providing this additional service.

Our Growing Practices

Each of the farms in our Farmer Network are Certified Naturally Grown (CNG). CNG offers peer-review certification to farmers producing food for their local communities by working in harmony with nature. CNG farmers do not use any synthetic herbicides, pesticides, fertilizers, or genetically modified organisms.

Our Shared Commitments

We will do our best to provide you with an abundant variety of produce each week- however, extreme weather, pests, or other production factors may make this difficult some weeks. By joining our Farm Share, you agree to accept this risk of crop uncertainty. In the event of crop failure/shortage, we will make up for this by filling your order with other crops grown on the farm that are ready for harvest at that time or by including more of other items.

Picking Up Shares

You are responsible for picking up your share every week from one of the following locations:

*If you are a part of a group or organization that has 10 or more Farm Share members, we will work with your group organizer to arrange a time and place for your delivery.

If you cannot pick-up your share, you must let us know before your scheduled time. We will attempt to work out an alternative arrangement. If you wish to change your pick-up day, you must let us know no later than the day before your scheduled pick up. Shares that are not retrieved within the pick-up time will be forfeited. Please plan to move your produce to a cool location as soon as possible upon picking your share up and wash all food before eating.
