





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











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


HOW DID YOU FIND THE CURRICULUM?







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
WERE READING MATERIALS AND REFERENCES REGARDING CURRICULUM / SUBJECTS EASILY FOUND?


WERE THE SUBJECTS RELEVANT TO YOUR JOB AND YOUR FUTURE ASPIRATIONS?


WERE THE SUBJECTS APPLICABLE IN YOUR PRACTICAL / DAILY LIFE?

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Feedback Analysis Report

Most of the students were satisfied with the various aspects of teaching like coverage of syllabus in class, emphasis on fundamentals, coverage of modern/advanced topics and overall course. 83.9% students felt that the curriculum is easy and 93.3% students felt that the instructions were easy to follow. 85.3% students responded that reading materials and reference books regarding subjects were easily found. 94.4% students commented that the subjects were relevant to job and future aspirations thus indicating that this curriculum provides larger scope for employability. Also the subjects are applicable in practical life. 93.7% students felt that the course helped them in building their personality.

Suggestions from students:

1. Few students felt that the syllabus should have more approach to competitive exams like UPSC and MPSC.
2. Few students suggested that curriculum should have still more practical approach especially in science faculty.
3. Few students suggested that there should be smart learning environment.

Action Taken:

In view of identifying the gap in the syllabus as per the requirement of various stakeholders, the college has taken feedback on curriculum from the students regarding their subject. Suggestions like more smart and experiential learning and approach to competitive exams, relevant to the framing of the syllabus of various courses were consolidated and discussed in IQAC and CDC, then communicated to the subject teacher. It was decided in IQAC to communicate this feedback report to University through BOS members.

Since more than 70% of the teachers of the institution are actively participating in the syllabus restructuring process, as being members of Board of studies. These suggestions were communicated to the chairmen of different boards for the proper redressal of suggestions. As suggested by IQAC following actions were prominently taken-

1. To help undergraduate fresh students understand the challenges and opportunities present in the Institute and to counsel their academic and personal problems 'Students Mentoring System' is introduced.
2. More MPSC/UPSC guidance and career guidance lectures were conducted and a lot of reading material on these areas is included in library.
3. Students are made aware of these facilities during Orientation Programs in the beginning.
4. More of industrial visits and field visits are conducted now. Also teachers are asked to undertake more experiential teaching learning process. Teachers are also using PowerPoint presentations for enhancing teaching learning experience.
5. Expert guidance lectures are conducted on different topics of advanced sciences to inculcate interest in subjects.

6. Many faculties are now using ICT for teaching learning purposes to create smart learning environment.
7. COLLEGE FEST (ARTS, COMMERCE and SCIENCE) was conducted to make students job ready and enhance their life skills.
8. Slow learners and advanced learners are given more attention according to their needs.
9. Bridge Courses and skill oriented courses have been introduced to bridge the knowledge gap and to make students more skilled.
10. Extension activities for social and environment sensitization are conducted.
11. More career guidance and soft skill development schemes have been implemented.
12. More faculty development programs have been conducted.
13. Placement and guidance cell has been strengthened.

We asked our students to give a special comment on the curriculum of the university. Based on the comments of the alumni, the analysis is done as follows:






