<p>2. Is the seat less than 10 years old? a. Disregard expiration dates if the seat is less than 10 years old.</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Yes, Continue <input type="checkbox"/> No. Destroy the seat/ or recycle! It is no longer safe to use.</p>
<p>3. Is the seat labeled as meeting current Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards?</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Yes. Continue <input type="checkbox"/> No. Destroy! It is no longer safe; do not use.</p>
<p>4. Does the seat have basic instruction labels?</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Yes. Continue <input type="checkbox"/> No. Print instructions if able to include with seat.</p>
<p>5. Has the seat been involved in a vehicle crash?</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> No. Continue. <input type="checkbox"/> Yes. Destroy the seat/ or recycle It is no longer safe to use. <input type="checkbox"/> Unknown? The seat may have hidden damage. Does the seat appear to be in good working condition? Use best judgment.</p>
<p>6. Has the seat been recalled for safety defects?</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> No. Continue <input type="checkbox"/> Yes. Have the defects been corrected? <input type="radio"/> Yes, Continue <input type="radio"/> No. Destroy the seat/ or recycle It is no longer safe.</p>
<p>7. Are there any splits, cracks, bends or breaks in the plastic shell or metal frame?</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> No. Continue <input type="checkbox"/> Yes. Destroy the seat/ or recycle It is no longer safe to use.</p>
<p>8. Do you have the instruction book?</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Yes. Continue <input type="checkbox"/> No. Order a new set or print one from the manufacturer's Web site if able.</p>
<p>9. Does the seat have all its parts: harness straps, pads/upholstery, harness retainer clip, etc.?</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Yes. Continue. You MUST refer to the car seat instructions to see if all parts are present! <input type="checkbox"/> No. Destroy the seat/ or recycle - or obtain replacement parts from the manufacturer.</p>
<p>10. Are the harness straps worn, damaged or frayed?</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> No. Continue <input type="checkbox"/> Yes. Destroy the seat/ or recycle.</p>
<p>11. Is there rust in the buckle area?</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> No. Continue <input type="checkbox"/> Yes. Destroy the seat/ or recycle.</p>
<p>12. Does the buckle mechanism fasten securely, remain fastened, and unfasten smoothly?</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Yes. You may consider using this seat. <input type="checkbox"/> No. Destroy the seat/ or recycle.</p>
