was submitted in writing at a regular meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Lincoln Park, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, held on August 18, 2017, and was introduced, read by title, and passed on first reading. The Governing Body of the Borough of Lincoln Park will further consider the Ordinance for second reading and final passage thereof at the regular meeting to be held on September 18, 2017, at 7:30 p.m. prevailing time at the Municipal Building in the Borough located at 32 Chapel Hill Road, New Jersey, at which time and place a public hearing thereon by the Governing Body and all parties in interest and citizens shall have an opportunity to be heard concerning said Ordinance.

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF LINCOLN PARK, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY
AUTHORIZING THE CHANGE OF BRIDGEWATER LANE TO UNGERER WAY PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:67-1a(k)**

Statement of Purpose: The purpose of this Ordinance is to change the street name of Bridgewater Lane to Ungerer Way.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:67-1(k) provides for the naming and/or changing of street names within a municipality; and

WHEREAS, Ungerer and Company is a global company with operations in 10 countries; and

WHEREAS, Ungerer and Company will celebrate its 125th anniversary in 2018; and

WHEREAS, Ungerer and Company commenced operations in the Borough of Lincoln Park in 1979 after leaving New York City; and

WHEREAS, over the past 38 years Ungerer and Company has expanded its operations and acquisition of property in the Borough of Lincoln Park; and

WHEREAS, Ungerer and Company built a new laboratory facility in 2013 in the Borough of Lincoln Park; and

WHEREAS, with its purchase 2 Bridgewater Lane in January 2017, Ungerer and Company now owns all lots on Bridgewater Lane; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of Ungerer and Company's almost 40 year continuous and expanding commitment and investment in the Borough of Lincoln Park, the Mayor and Borough Council have concluded to rename Bridgewater Lane to Ungerer Way pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:67-1(k).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of Lincoln Park, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The governing body does hereby change the name of Bridgewater Lane to Ungerer Way pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:67-1(k).

Section 2. The Borough of Lincoln Park Post Office shall be notified of such name change by provision of a copy of this Ordinance.

Section 3. The Borough of Lincoln Park Police Department, Fire Department and Tax Assessor/Collector Office shall be notified of such name change by provision of a copy of this Ordinance.

Section 4. The Borough of Lincoln Park Engineering Department and Engineer shall be notified of such name change by provision of a copy of this Ordinance to the extent required by the Borough of Lincoln Park Code.

Section 5. Appropriate signage shall be installed to reflect the street name change.

Section 6. To the extent applicable, a copy of this Ordinance shall be filed in the Office of the Morris County Register in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:67-2.

Section 7. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provision of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder of any portion thereof.

Section 8. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances of the Borough of Lincoln Park which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 9. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication on the manner provided by law.
