SUBJ: Howe Creek Public Art

RECOMMENDATION:

That Council approve the inclusion of the Eagle's Nest Wood Sculpture in the proposed 2020 Howe Creek trail project.

BACKGROUND:

The proposed Howe Creek trail project is a continued collaboration between the City of Terrace and Terrace Community Forest to improve accessibility, amenities, vegetation and overall safety for users of the parklands.

This year's proposed project includes continued trail upgrades with connections through private properties, bridge replacement, signage improvements and the suggested wood sculpture. The idea for the wood sculpture was organized and presented to me by Terrace Community Forest and after consideration and review I recommend that Council approve.

The artist would be JJ's Woodart and he has already started on some of the pieces of the project. If approved, the wood sculpture will be located on one of the main trail intersections behind Rowland Crescent and within the City parklands.

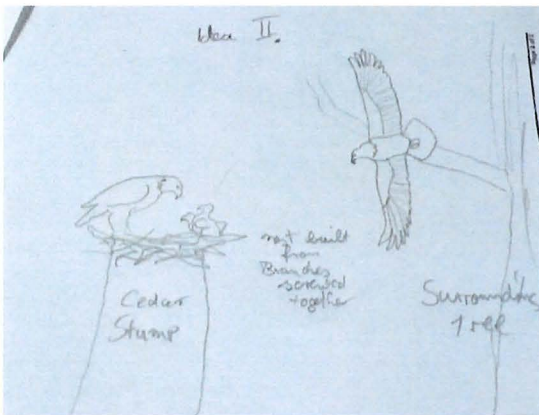
