Toilet Cleaning Checklist Monthly

Flush Handle: Deep clean and sanitize the flush handle.
Toilet Seat: Thoroughly clean and disinfect both the top and bottom of the toilet
seat.
Toilet Lid: Scrub and disinfect the top and underside of the toilet lid.
Toilet Rim: Use a strong cleaner to scrub under the rim to remove any built-up
grime.
Toilet Bowl: Apply a heavy-duty toilet cleaner and scrub thoroughly to remove
stains and buildup.
Toilet Exterior: Clean and disinfect the entire exterior of the toilet, including
hard-to-reach areas behind and at the base.

Deodorize Room: Use a room deodorizer or scented cleaner to freshen up the
bathroom space.
