

Proposal

West Virginia State University Scholarship

Purpose and Overview:

The West Virginia State University Scholarship Program would be developed to attract qualified high school students to attend West Virginia State University. The WVSU Scholarship would be awarded in the amount of \$2,000.00 per year (\$1,000.00 per semester) to assist in the payment of tuition charges for 100 qualified students. The WVSU Scholarship may be awarded for a maximum of four years.

Eligibility by High School Students

To qualify a high school student must have a high school grade-point average of 2.90 and attained an ACT composite score of 20 or more.

Requirements

1. Complete and sign the Offer for a West Virginia State University Scholarship form by May 1st for the academic year beginning in August of that year.
2. Provide a copy of high school transcripts and ACT score by May 1st.

Continued Eligibility

A student may retain the West Virginia State University Scholarship at West Virginia State University by attaining a minimum grade point average of 2.75 each semester and by reapplying for the scholarship each subsequent year. The WVSU Scholarship may be awarded for a maximum of four years.

Exclusions

The WVSU Scholarship shall be not available to a student who has also been awarded a Promise Scholarship or awarded a tuition waiver by WVSU.

Implementation

WVSU would establish a budget line for the WVSU Scholarship by allocating funds as follows:

\$200,000.00 for Year 1

\$400,000.00 for Year 2

\$600,000.00 for Year 3

\$800,000.00 for Year 4 and there after.
