





## Video Production

WeVideo is a great option for video production. It is an easy to use cloud-based video editing and sharing suite. You can edit horizontally, vertical or square. It includes a music, sound effects, and graphics library. If you get the business plan, a more extensive library with b-roll (video) and graphics is included. ### ***Free Video Editing Software***

- YouTube Video Editor – YouTube has upgraded its editing software over the years. It will get the job done.
- iMovie – If you have an iPhone, iPad, or apple product
- Androids – You can use the edit option once you have shot your video. This is primarily for very short videos that you want to upload to social media.
- Lightworks – Paid version is Lightworks Pro
- Hitfilm Express – Paid version is Hitfilm Pro
- Blender – Free and open-source 3D computer graphics software

## **Cameras**

The cameras below are what I use for shooting video and taking pictures. There are always cheaper versions you can find. It really depends on what you're trying to accomplish. I tend to shoot a lot of videos for the City and it is important that I have a camera that shoots in HD and 4K. However, you will save money if you go on Amazon, instead of buying directly from the manufacturer. Plus, Amazon sells

cameras in bundles. You will often get a tripod, batteries, lenses, case, sometimes a microphone, and several other accessories.

**Sony AX33 4K Handycam** – Shoot 4K footage that contains about four times more detail than Full HD footage. You can find this in a bundle on Amazon for as low as \$698.00.



## Options

These days your **Android** or **iPhone cameras** are just as sharp as an HD camera. You can also use different filters and effects.

**Facebook Live and Twitter Live** – You can capture events live on your City’s Twitter and Facebook channels. If you don’t have time to edit a video, you can always go live.

**Pixlr** is a free online photo editor. It’s basically the free version of Adobe Photoshop.

**Snapseed** is a free photo editing app for both iOS mobile devices and Android. You can create photo frames, textures, lighting effects, etc.

**Closed Captioning** – For closed captioning **Rev.com** is a great and inexpensive option. You upload your video and they do all the work. After Rev.com is done captioning they will send you a srt file to upload to your Facebook or YouTube video. It is \$1 per minute. While closed captioning is free on YouTube and Facebook, it is not going to be exact. You will end up spending a lot of time syncing the words with the video and making corrections. It is best to submit a script with your video to Rev.com. Rev.com will get your video closed captioned faster if you provide a script.


## Graphics




**Digital Juice** is a royalty-free content provider for video, print, and presentations. This includes graphics that divided up by different themes. For example, if you are looking for school related content or Christmas content, you will find an array of options under the specific theme (graphics, animations, b-roll, etc. for flyers, videos, and presentations). ## Free Options





## UTILIZE STAFF



As a one-person department you cannot be everywhere at the same time. This is when your colleagues can help. As Communications Director I feel that it is important to show the public what our employees do on a day to day basis. Your Public Works and Parks and Recreation employees are always out and about working on various projects. Ask them to text or email you a few pictures if they are paving the street, fixing a pothole, cleaning a park, etc. This gives you extra social media content and it's free. Your best storytellers are the people working around you.

In the City of Buda we often share resources. For example, if I need someone to make an elaborate flyer, I reach out to our Tourism Coordinator who is creative and great with graphics. If the Main Street Director needs someone to shoot and edit a video, I will help her out. Everyone has a busy schedule, but when possible, utilize the employees around you. This can save you money by not having to contract out for services. We also sometimes share equipment like tripods or cameras.

## INTERNS

Interns can be a tremendous help, especially if you are a one-person department. The City of Buda is surrounded by community colleges and universities and we take advantage of this free resource. My intern over the summer created videos, wrote press releases, and helped me take care of the smaller things. Some high schools also have internship programs.
