Exhibition Proposal Guidelines

Please read the following guidelines carefully. Incomplete proposals will not be reviewed and will be returned without consideration. Each submission must include the following:

1. Exhibition Proposal Statement
2. Artist biographical information/resume
3. Artist statement
4. 5 – 10 digital images of proposed artwork as jpegs at 300 dpi
5. An exhibition budget, prospectus, and timeline, if applicable
6. Any catalogs, press, or other support materials
7. A self-addressed stamped envelope in the event we return your materials
