If grade appropriate, post the words in the classroom. • Begin reading, asking questions, and discussing the article(s) on Page1. 	Lesson (1 period) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Review vocabulary words and topics discussed on Day 1/ Page1. • Read, ask questions, and discuss the articles on Pages2 and 3. • Choose content-related activities, writing prompts and/or worksheets for students to complete independently/ cooperatively. 	Lesson Cont'd (1 period) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Review vocabulary words and topics discussed on Days 1 and 2/ Pages1-3. • Continue to read, ask questions, and discuss the articles featured on Pages 2 and 3. • Choose content-related activities, writing prompts and/or worksheets for students to complete independently/ cooperatively. 	Page 4 Activities (1 period) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Review vocabulary words and concepts discussed in the unit. • Assign/Complete the Page 4 activities independently/ cooperatively. • Choose content-related activities, writing prompts, and/ or worksheets for students to complete independently/ cooperatively. • Review unit concepts for the assessment. 	Assessment and Project Extensions (1 period) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have students take the weekly assessment online or distribute hard copies for students to complete. • To conclude the lesson, choose an extension activity, worksheet, or writing prompt not completed earlier in the week.
