3-- Your Chair is working with the City and the Neighborhood Traffic Safety Alliance (NTSA) to address the speeds on Evergreen Blvd and Shorewood Drive. The current speed limit is 25 mph and recent speed checks on Evergreen Blvd found that the average speeds between 5th St and Shorewood Drive were 42.9-44 mph. The volume of cars on week day were 4,486 to 4,627. I think the speeds create a safety hazard for all. The Two Radar speed devices do not appear to be slowing down the traffic. I will be working to find other methods to slow or calm the traffic and submit a "Speed Calming Grant" for funds. If you have suggestions please email them to me.
