WISH Drop-In Centre Society is currently looking for new **Support Workers to drive the MAP Van**. The MAP Van provides nightly service to women (trans inclusive) engaged in street-based sex work throughout the city of Vancouver. The women need us now more than ever and we need your help to do so!

- You have a **Class 5 Driver's licence!**
- You can work overnight shifts as a casual employee and can be available for on call
- You will work with a fun and dynamic team of two employees on the Van
- You provide mobile outreach services and supports to women (trans inclusive) engaged in street-based sex work throughout the city of Vancouver.
- You will provide support to a constant flow of participants to ensure their access to basic needs, services, and supports, including information and referral, first aid supplies, harm reduction supplies, sex work supplies, clothing/toiletries/makeup donations, and snacks.
- You will work one-on-one to assess participants and recommend appropriate services to participants.

Hours of work: 10:00pm to 6:00am

Wages: Starting at \$20.52/hour (classified at grid level 10/CUPE Local 1936)



The **MAP Van (Mobile Access Project)** provides outreach services to women working on the street every night, every day of the year. Many sex-working women work in areas of the city where there are few or no services open late at night. These women are extremely vulnerable, and often targeted.
