

Instructions for Player Evaluation Sheet

- 1) All Categories are scored 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5. *No decimals or fractions*
- 2) **5** = the highest/**best** score. **1** = lowest/**worst** score.
- 3) Please separate your rosters by appropriate grade!
 - a. Entering 4th Graders - Tryout for U10
 - b. Entering 5th Graders - Tryout for U11
 - c. Entering 6th Graders - Tryout for U12
 - d. Entering 7th/8th Graders – Tryout for U14
- 4) Order Rosters Alphabetically by Last Name & Grade.
 - a. For Example..

Last Name	First Name	Grade	Team Rank	Total Eval Score	Team
Alexander	Joe	3	4	45	NSC
Jones	Brett	3	2	48	NSC
Claxton	Mike	4	1	49	NSC
Smith	Tom	4	6	39	NSC

- 5) Base the score for each of your players, in every category, off of what you feel the best player in the entire league would get. This is intended to avoid having the best player on your team receive all 5's. We **do NOT** want you to compare everyone on your team around the best player on your team. **Instead** we want you to think about what the best or “ideal” player in the league would score on a specific category and then think about how your specific player stacks up to that “ideal” player.
- 6) Carefully consider the ranking order of the players on your team. This does not necessarily have to match up with the “Total Eval Score” section. It may work out that way, however the game of soccer is not that easily quantifiable. So please feel free to include in the “Additional Comment” section the reason behind any decisions that may need some explanation.
- 7) Please consider making any notes that are of significance for particular players. I.E “he/she would like to specialize in Goal Keeper”, “Shows good skills in practice but doesn't seem very motivated or engaged.” The More information coaches have during the selection meeting will go a long way in helping with some of the final selections. Each coach has a particular style of play and when evaluation scores are tight, the comments can be what encourages a coach to choose a particular player over another!
