

Traditional Student Information Sheet

The notes below are to help us navigate as we return to school under COVID-19 guidelines. These notes will assist our Eagle family as we transition back to school in the safest manner possible.

Personal Safety and Provided PPE

- All students are required to take a COVID-19 Self-Health Assessment prior to coming to school each day. If you have any of the following symptoms:
 - Fever equal to or greater than 100°F
 - Chills/aches
 - Headache
 - Diarrhea
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath
 - Loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Someone in my household has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days
- Plexiglass Sneeze Guards will be provided for each student and teacher desk.
- Cleaning wipes will be provided for each student and will remain at their desk.
- Masks/Face shields **must** be worn at all times, beginning with entering the building.
- Bus riders will be required to wear face masks upon loading the bus, on the bus and exiting the bus.
- The following signs will be posted: *Wear a Mask upon Entry, Hand Washing reminder, Hand Sanitizing Stations, Water Bottle Filling Station, etc.*

Arrival

- Only student bus riders will be allowed to enter the building before 7am.
- All doors will open at 7am and students will report directly to first period class.
 - If a student has items to drop off for band, athletics, drill, etc., the student will drop their items off at the appropriate area then head directly to their first period.
- No morning clubs/organizations, library, etc. will take place for at least the first six weeks.
- Morning tutorials will be suspended through the first six weeks.
- Breakfast will be eaten in the cafeteria.
- Late arrival students will have their temperature checked at the attendance office.

Masks

- Masks are required at all times except when eating or in classrooms when seated behind a shield.
- Masks will need to adhere to the district guidelines: covering nose/mouth and be free of written messages and symbols. However, students may wear BH "spirit" face masks.

Transitions

- Masks/face shields must be worn at all times in the hallway.
- Social distance as much as possible in hallways and in restrooms.
- Stay on the right side of the hallway.

Entering/Exiting and Classroom Cleanup

- As students enter the classroom, they must use hand sanitizer, take their seat, clean their Plexiglass Sneeze Guards, desk area, get their materials out, and when ready to learn, they can take off their mask (if they so choose).
- Before students exit the classroom, they will clean their Plexiglass Sneeze Guards and desk area.

Classroom Protocols

- Teachers will socially distant students as much as possible.
- Temperature checks for students will be conducted by first period teachers. If a student has a temp of 100°F higher after 2 temperature checks, student will be sent to the nurse.
- Students will have access to sanitizer and disinfectant.
- If moving about in the classroom, put your mask on.
- Student movement in the classroom will be limited until physical distancing requirements are lifted.

Lunch

- Tables will be marked with stickers to mark where students **cannot** sit.
- No food drop offs.
- No microwaves for student use in the cafeteria until further notice.
- Students must social distance while in line and wear their mask.
- Please use cash as a last resort. Use the online system or pay before school.

Dismissal

- Car riders and the first bus run will exit the building immediately. Face masks must be worn.
- Bus riders: 2nd bus run will sit at the top level of the cafeteria and 3rd bus run will sit on the bottom level. Students will follow the same seating protocol as lunch. Students will find out their bus run before the end of the first day of school.

ID Badges

- ID badges will be distributed during 3rd period the first day of school.
- ID badges must be worn at all times while in the building.
- ID badges will be worn around the neck with the provided district lanyard and be visible.
 - Students are not allowed to change the provided district lanyard.
- Students will use their ID badge for lunch, library, etc.

Miscellaneous

- Clear drinking containers will be allowed with water only.
- Parents will not be allowed to pass beyond the foyer without an appointment. Parents will have a temperature check and will need to complete a COVID self-assessment before preceding to their appointment.
- Parents will attend ARD and 504 meetings virtually when possible.
- Teacher/parent conferences will need to be virtual when possible.
- Programs with visitors have been suspended until further notice.
- Visitors will not be allowed on campus without an appointment scheduled.
