## **Monday** Mix and Match (\$1 or a can good food item)

Advisory Lessons – Kick of Unity Day Celebration with our Students!

Lesson will include:

- Explanation of weeks activities and the meaning of Unity Day and it's importance in Bullying Prevention
- An activity where students come up with a positive statement that supports acceptance, kindness and inclusion in our Bates community. Students will create a link and the Counseling Department will link all the statements together and display them for the students on the 23<sup>rd</sup>.

Students will talk at their tables with someone new about the barrier written on the (paper) brick and discuss ideas on how to eliminate the barrier from the Bates culture.
- Students participating in the activity will get a treat – (All students!)
