The List: (...check it twice!)

- 1) Shovel someone's driveway
- 2) Make a snowman wearing a mask
- 3) Color some Christmas pages as a family (pages provided)
- 4) Tell someone (*friend, neighbor, family member*) the true meaning of Christmas
- 5) The "stable" sleep over- *Pick a room in the house and the whole family sleeps over in it.*
- 6) Read the whole Christmas story chronologically: *Luke 1:26-38/ Matt 1:18-25/ Luke 1: 39-56/ Luke 2:1-21/ Matt 2:1-12/ Luke 2:22-38/ Matt 2:13-15- Kids can "act out" the story or use the nativity set to reenact the events as you read.*
- 7) Give someone you don't know a small gift
- 8) Donate items to those in need
- 9) Go sledding as a family
- 10) Take time for a family prayer time (*Prayer items: the church around the world, that the gospel message would be heard, for family and friends*)
- 11) Zoom call with family and friends
- 12) Watch a Christmas movie (...or 2 or 3 or 4...)
