

Diabetes Daily Food and Exercise Log

Directions:

- Check your blood glucose before you eat and write down the results. List the time you eat and the amount of all food and drink consumed, as well as how many grams of carbohydrates you consume.
- Two hours after eating, check your blood glucose and write down the results.
- List the time you exercise, length of activity, intensity level (light, moderate, heavy), and activity performed.
- List blood glucose results before and after exercise.
- Check with your doctor or a registered dietician to determine what your appropriate daily carbohydrate intake should be based on your weight management goals.
- Talk with your doctor about your blood glucose goals and how often you should check your blood glucose.
- Before beginning any exercise program, talk with your doctor about which types of exercise are appropriate for you.
