If this interests you, we are asking that you do the following three things:

- (1) Parents should read the student handbook either on-line (VB website) or in the front of the planner they will be returning, then sign the handbook sheet included in the first day packet (it states that you understand the policies).
- (2) The necessary information should be filled in below to participate in the "Ipad/Ipod for Planner" program and the slip turned in with the student fee payment...please return the planner with your payment.
- (3) The student MUST receive a digital drivers license (DDL) from Mr. Doe (training time is flexible and minimal).
