



SUGGESTED SCHEDULE OF WEDDING DAY
BASED ON 2PM CEREMONY SERVICE

- 8.00am Access to the Getting Ready Room
- 9.00am Suppliers and wedding party have access to the function rooms
- 1.00pm Doors open - bar open for guests
- 1.15pm Registrar arrives
- 1.45pm Guests take their seats for the ceremony
- 2.00pm The ceremony takes place
- 2.30pm Drinks reception begins
- 2.45pm Canapés are served
- 3.00pm Guests check in following any group photos
- 4.00pm Guests are welcomed to the dining room – couple freshen up as needed
- 4.15pm Newlywed couple are announced into the room
- 4.20pm Wedding meal is served
- 5.40pm After main course, cutting of the cake*
- 6.30pm Speeches **
- 7.00pm Tea/coffee served in the Baronial Hall ***
- 7.00pm Evening Guests start to arrive to the Baronial Hall ****
- 8.00pm First Dance & Party!
- 9.00pm Evening buffet served with the wedding cake
- 12.00am Music finishes and bar closes
- 12.30am Carriages

Monday – Saturday weddings are due to finish at Midnight, Sunday weddings are due to finish at 11:30pm.

* From our experience, we have found the best time to cut the cake is during the meal. If you would prefer to cut the cake in the evening, then this of course can be an option.

** We recommend that speeches take place after the wedding breakfast as we find they tend to run over time and we would not want your food to get cold waiting to be served!

*** Tables are cleared away ready for evening bands/dancefloors/photobooths to be set up.

**** Evening guests should be invited to arrive a minimum of 5 hours after your ceremony time otherwise they may arrive during your dessert or speeches. For larger weddings or with longer speeches or any additional elements added, we advise a later arrival time for evening guests.

The above suggested schedule is based on a 2pm wedding, but if you are having a different ceremony time or would like to tweak the timings, then please do contact us and we will be happy to discuss this with you. We will also go through the schedule together at your final details meeting.
